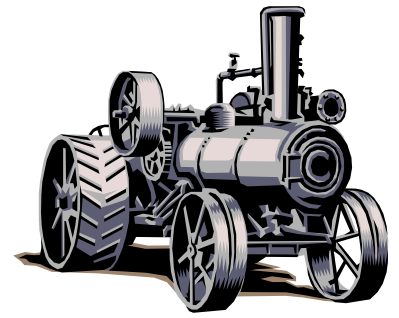

The following conditions apply for this event.

Exhibits must be on show ground for 10am each day and must comply with safety conditions in operation for the rally.

All exhibits must have public liability insurance for this event with a minimum indemnity of £2,000,000.

The road traffic act now applies to all places where the public have access;

Therefore driving vehicles without insurance, MOT (where applicable) or a valid driving licence cannot be permitted. In the interests of their safety children must not be allowed to ride on tractors or machinery.

All pressure vessels and boilers must have current certificates.

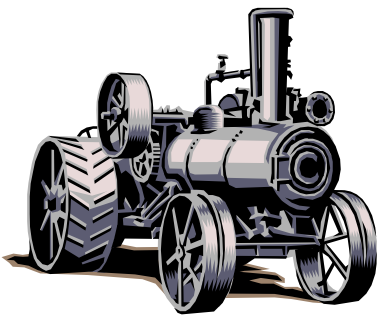

Conditions to ensure safety and a smooth running event for all

- All traders should ensure they book sufficient space to contain all guy-ropes which they require, a site will be allocated and marked out for each trader. No traders should take up a larger space than they have been allocated.
- The site should be left clean and tidy, anybody that leaves litter will be excluded from next years Border City Steam Fair.
- Traders must NOT sell any item which could be regarded as a weapon such as guns/replica guns/ bow and arrows etc. Also forbidden is the sale of 'stink bombs' due to the fact they are anti-social and add to litter onsite.
- All traders must have adequate fire fighting equipment available for inspection should this be requested.
- All generators, wiring and appliances should conform to IEE Wiring Regulations.
- All dogs must be kept on a lead and be kept under proper control. Please clean up after them.
- There is to be no mock auctions.
- It is forbidden for any person who does not hold the appropriate driving/operating licence to drive/ operate vehicles and machinery onsite.
- There is to be no vehicle movement between the times of 9am and 4.30pm during the event. This includes any 'test drives' of vehicles which are being sold including quad bikes and such like.
- Traders must follow instruction given by the organisers and stewards at all times.
- The organisers reserve the right at all times to refuse admittance to any trader/exhibitor/caterer/ staff. In the event of a dispute The Border City Steam Fair Organisers decision is final.

Declaration:

I declare that during the period of the rally my entry will be covered by public and product liability insurance of not less than £2,000,000 and I also agree to abide by the rules laid down by the organisers.

In default of this declaration, I agree to indemnify and hold harmless the organisers of this event, stewards, helpers or any person acting on their instructions or behalf from any claim for accidental damage or personal injury whatsoever, or death howsoever caused by my exhibit and my participation in this event. I have read and agree to abide and comply with the above conditions and risk assessment.
